FOURTH REGULAR SESSION, 1988 CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 5-377, C.D.1, C.D.2

## AN ACT

To further amend title 9 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 5-70, by amending section 706 for the purpose of providing for exceptions to the seven day's notice requirement for voting at a polling place other than the one at which a voter is legally registered to vote, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 706 of title 9 of the Code of the Federated 1 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 706. Voting at another polling place. 3 (1) A voter shall have the right to vote on election 4 day at a polling place other than the polling place at which 5 he is legally registered to vote if the following conditions 6 are met: (a) the voter is present in his State on the day 8 9 of election; (b) he is lawfully registered to vote in his 10 representative or election district; and 11 (c) he notifies the national election 12 13 commissioner in writing at least seven days before the election that he will not be voting in his proper voting 14 15 place and that he requests to vote at a specific voting 16 place. (2) Upon receipt of voter's request for a change in 17 18 polling place, and no later than five days from such receipt if request is made seven days before the election, 19 the national election commissioner shall immediately 20 assign and notify the voter by any means of communication, 21

including the use of radio, as to the place where the voter

1	may vote. Upon such notification, the voter shall be
2	permitted to vote only at that polling place.
3	(3) The national election commissioner shall cause a
4	mark to be placed next to the name of the voter in that
5	part of the General State Register for the election
6	precinct or the polling place where the voter would
7	normally cast his ballot. This mark shall indicate that
8	the voter will be casting his ballot at another polling
9	place and that he is prohibited from voting in that
10	election at his usual polling place. The national election
11	commissioner shall provide the proper ballot at the newly
12	designated polling place for each voter who complies with
13	the provisions of this section.
14	(4) The seven day notice requirement in subsection
15	(1) of this section may be waived by the national election
16	commissioner if the following conditions are met:
17	(a) the voter was unable to give sufficient
18	notice because circumstances beyond his control made
19	it impossible or extremely difficult to do so;
20	(b) the voter gives at least one day's notice in
21	writing; and
22	(c) the waiver would not prevent compliance
23	with any other provision of this section."
